Students, Parents, and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you well. I wanted to inform you about the critical components of Distance Learning starting Monday April 13th through Friday May 22nd.

- 1. Google Classroom, Remind, and Google Meet are the digital resources I will use to communicate with you.
 - a. Students are already joined, but any parent/guardian can join by going to <u>classroom.google.com</u> using the class code: ewn4mkl
 - b. Join Remind- Remind.com or using the phone app- class code: @mrleemath3
 - c. You will receive access links for the live Google Meets when they occur through Google Classroom and Remind. This will not be used extensively due to privacy concerns. No need to sign up or join. <u>Disclaimer:</u> When you participate in a google meet you are giving your consent to be recorded.
- 2. Assignments are posted in Google Classroom weekly.
 - a. Every assignment is for **Quarter 3 grade improvement (current grade on Aeries)** only.
 - i. Points for completed assignments will be posted and updated on Google Classroom and eventually on Aeries.
 - ii. All assessments are formative to demonstrate learning of assigned weekly objectives.
 - iii. Summative assessments will not be given out.
 - iv. Although none of the previously assigned work/assessments can be made up or ammended, every assignment posted during Distance Learning will be used to help students' grades in the class. They cannot be penalized from not doing any work (District-wide policy).
 - b. Lessons assigned for completion are designed to take <u>two hours per week</u> and they are to be turned in each week no later than Friday at 5pm for grade improvement. Generally, there will be one review learning objective and one new learning objective to complete weekly.
- 3. Virtual Instruction/Content support
 - a. If you need additional assistance with lessons, please do not hesitate to contact me at any time via email or Remind.
 - b. My official office hours are Mon, Tu, Th: 10:00pm-10:30pm, Wednesdays: 2-3pm, Fridays 10:30-11:00am. However, I do receive emails and Remind's at any time so you may still contact me around the clock. Please be mindful that outside of those office hours my responses may not be prompt.
